CLASSROOM TEACHERS MAY REQUEST ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES.

DRESS CODE

1. No shorts, skirts, dresses, splits, or holes in clothing shorter than four inches above the knee.

5. No head covering is allowed on campus during school.
6. No sunglasses are to be worn in the building.
7. No pajamas or bedroom shoes.
8. No inappropriate or profane signs, emblems, or language on clothing.

ID CARDS

All students **are required** to have a current year school ID card. ID cards are required for hall passes and to attend school activities. The first ID card is free; a replacement card is \$10.00.

PLANNERS

All students will be issued a planner to track their academic progress. A replacement planner can be purchased for \$10.00.

LOCKS / LOCKERS

School locks are required to utilize school lockers. School locks are \$10.00. Only combination locks purchased from the school may be utilized. All students are responsible for items found in their lockers. Students may not share a locker with another student. Unsecured or inappropriately secured lockers will be cleared.

TRANSPARENT/MESH BOOKBAGS

Only transparent/mesh bookbags are allowed in classrooms. Book bags, duffel bags, large purses, instrument cases, or similar items may be used for the purpose of transporting books, other school related items and personal effects to and from school. Upon entering the school, all book bags, duffel bags, large purses, instrument cases, or similar items, **unless transparent or mesh** must be secured in a school locker.
