MG James Ursano Scholarship (AER)	<u>04/01/2019</u>	<p>The MG James Ursano Scholarship Program is a need-based scholarship program established to assist children of Army Soldiers in obtaining their first undergraduate degree.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student must be a dependent of a Soldier on federal active duty, a retired Soldier, or a deceased active or deceased retired Soldier. Children of National Guard/Reserve Soldiers are eligible if the Soldier is on Title 10 Orders for the entire academic year. • Student must be registered as a dependent of the Soldier in DEERS (Defense Eligibility Enrollment Reporting System) • Student must be under the age of 24 (eligibility ends at the end of the semester/term in which the student reaches their 24th birthday. Example – turning 24 in December would mean the scholarship would be awarded for fall term ONLY) • Student must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and demonstrate financial need as evidenced by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) • Student must apply online by April 1, 2019 – www.aerhg.org
Cumberland County Association of Principals & Assistant Principals (CACPAP) 2019 Scholarship	<u>04/11/2019</u>	<p>To be considered eligible for the CACPAP scholarship, students must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be a 2018-2019 high school senior in CCS and maintain a minimum weighted 2.5 GPA • Complete the essay portion of the scholarship as directed • Include an official transcript and a current report card with the application • Turn the completed packet in by the scholarship deadline to the specified location • Scholarship Deadline: April 11, 2019 • Stop by the Student Counseling Center to pick up an application or download the application from the Class of 2019 Google classroom
