NC State Good Night Scholars Program: Applicant must be a NC resident, plan to major in a STEM area and the applicant's family income cannot exceed \$110,000. NC State General application must be submitted by November 1st. You can self-nominate for the scholarship beginning November 1st. All application materials are due by January 11, 2021. Application deadline: February 12, 2021

Be a high school senior, between the ages of 16 and 19 at the time of application. Have a minimum 3.0 unweighted cumulative GPA at the time of application. Plan to attend a four-year college or university as an undergraduate student for the entire 2020-21 academic year. Be a child of an active-duty Service Member stationed at one of the following U.S. Military installations at the time of application or application due date: Fort Bragg, NC

Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Scholarship - Guidelines North Carolina Association of Educators (NCAE) and the North Carolina Foundation for Public School Children (NCFPSC). Applicants must be NORTH CAROLINA RESIDENTS enrolled in a public high school in their senior year. Criteria for selection include character, community involvement, and scholastic achievement.
